Scholarship Policies 2016 - 2017

It is expected that any athlete who applies for and receives a scholarship from Lakeland FC will conduct him/herself in a manner consistent with the Player Code of Conduct, and that his/her parents will conduct themselves in a manner consistent with the Parent Code of Conduct, including providing a positive support to the team and the Club. Behavior to the contrary could jeopardize the player's scholarship for the current year as well as future years.

Lakeland FC offers a limited number of partial scholarships, based strictly on need. Lakeland FC does not offer scholarships based on merit. Due to the great demand and the limited Club scholarship resources, no one is guaranteed a scholarship from one year to the next.

A player's selection to his/her team will be handled independently of their scholarship request or needs. scholarship requests are not known to the coaching staff prior to tryouts.

Scholarship players are expected to attend all practices and games; a lack of participation can result in possible removal from the team and a request to return the uniform, and will jeopardize any future scholarship requests.

All scholarship recipients will need to make arrangements to pay for their own uniform expenses which are handled separately from the Club. An initial Club Fee deposit is still necessary from scholarship applicants in order to receive their practice shirt, for the Club to proceed with the FYSA registration process and to hold their spot on the team.

Scholarships are not awarded in the form of cash. They are awarded in the form of credit against a player's Club fee first and any Team expenses second if the Club fee requirement has already been met.

Scholarship Applications will be reviewed and awarded by the Board in as timely a manner as possible immediately following registration. Outside of the Club Operations Manager, and the Board, all applications are confidential.
